

Rules for determining the translation volume

1. Translation volume is measured in standard pages. A standard page consists of 1,800 characters including whitespaces and punctuation marks.
2. As a rule, translation volume is determined according to the final text, and each document is evaluated separately. For translations from Russian into hieroglyphical and some other Oriental languages (Chinese, Japanese, Arabic, Korean, Persian, Dari, Hebrew, etc.) translation volume is evaluated based on the source text in Russian.
3. Translation volume is **preliminarily** estimated upon acceptance of an order, and is **finally** determined upon completion of translation with an accuracy of 0.1 page.
4. Minimum translation volume is equal to a standard page for each document included in the order. This means that, in any case, client pays for at least one standard page, regardless of the actual translation volume.
